

Stefano Scalera currently serves as Chief Executive Officer of INVIMIT SGR S.p.A., a company of the Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance. Since February 2011, he has been a First-Tier Executive and has held the position of Head of Department at the Ministry of Agriculture in 2023 and Deputy Chief of Staff to the Minister in 2024.

At the Ministry of Economy and Finance, he has held various positions, including Head of the Minister of Economy's Technical Secretariat, Adviser to the Minister of Economy for investments, and Deputy Chief of Staff to the Minister, focusing primarily on public debt, public investment, and public finance. He worked on the so-called "Juncker Plan," the investment clause, and the reform of the financial system.

Stefano has been a member of the Bureau of the Housing and Land Management Committee at UNECE, an adjunct board member of the European Investment Bank, and a member of the boards of directors of Ferrovie dello Stato Italiane and TELT, the company responsible for the construction of the Turin–Lyon rail link.
