Description: The Peace Institute's STEAM camps 2025 are aimed at bringing STEAM education to under privilege children in Nigeria and other parts of Africa. Through the development of an inclusive, practical and culturally responsive curriculum the pupils will be able to learn key concepts with practical experiments.

Target Beneficiaries: Boys and Girls aged 10-15

Location: Nigeria and Liberia

Time Period: 5 / 6 Weeks, July-August 2025

Volunteer: GG Students and Alumni who are motivated to impact lives of underprivileged children and to make a positive difference in the world

Role of the Volunteers: Read Instructors/Teachers manual and understand it clearly. Study the syllabus and agree with its contents (Allow to tweak if they wish). Volunteers will be tutors at the STEAM camps and will research and organize the materials for their specific activities.

Expenses: Volunteers will buy their flight tickets and pay for their visa application fees, have yellow-fever vaccination and other vaccinations) or medication related to prevention, such as anti-malaria treatment. Host will be responsible for security arrangements, medicals, transportation, Feeding, accommodation and other social events.

Other things to note: Volunteers will stay together during the STEAM camps. Volunteers may wish to have pocket money to cover any personal expenses. Further information may be provided, if needed.

Application Process: Volunteers will be required to complete the application form and will be later on interviewed on their motivations and capabilities.
