

## PH.D. in ECONOMICS and FINANCE

The PhD in Economics and Finance is a 4-year full-time program providing advanced specialization in economics, finance, and quantitative methods to students whose goal is to pursue a successful career in academia or in institutions that require first-rate research skills.

The program is hosted by the Department of Economics and Finance (DEF) at Tor Vergata University of Rome. It offers a distinguished faculty, promoting excellence in teaching and research, and a lively and international research environment. RePEc and Tilburg University rank DEF among the top 5 institutions in Italy, and the top 100 in Europe. The Department has been recently financed twice by the Italian Ministry of University and Research under the program "Departments of Excellence".

In the first year of the program, students take advanced core courses in Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Finance and Econometrics. After choosing their field of specialization, the subsequent three years are entirely dedicated to research, including attendance and presentation at departmental seminars.

## CALL FOR INTERESTS for A.Y. 2023/24

We are now advertising the positions for the next academic year with a full grant, which amounts to  $\leq 16,243$  per year (about  $\leq 1,200$  per month net of taxes, increased by 50% during the periods – up to one year - spent abroad for study and research).

A prerequisite for participating in the program is a **MSc university degree in Economics** or equivalent. All admissions are conditional on obtaining the MSc degree before the beginning of the program.

The selection is based on the evaluation of the candidate's profile from the documentation provided, and a personal interview.

- Research statement (1-2 pages max).
- Motivational Letter with Curriculum Vitae.
- Two reference letters.
- Transcript of M.Sc. courses and grades.
- English language proficiency certificate<sup>1</sup>.
- M.Sc. thesis (optional).
- Publications (if any).
- GRE and GMAT test scores (if any).

Promising applicants will be invited to an interview.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Such as IELTS/TOEFL/Cambridge C2 Proficiency/Cambridge C1 Advanced. No English language certificate is required from applicants who are English native speakers, and/or have been awarded a degree from a university program entirely taught in English and have written a thesis in English in such a program.



Since the number of positions is relatively small, **early applications are strongly encouraged.** Selected applicants **will receive offers sequentially**, pending formal application and admission through the official Call by Tor Vergata University of Rome in Spring 2023, and the positive evaluation of the PhD program by ANVUR and MUR for A.Y. 2023/24.
