	2 <sup>nd</sup> term	Fields exams	By the end of this period the student should have officially chosen the supervisor (who might be different from the tutor).	
2 <sup>nd</sup> year	1 <sup>st</sup> term	1 <sup>st</sup> "Research idea" seminar [2 <sup>nd</sup> half of Nov/Dec]	Student presents the Research Idea during the seminar. She/he might need to attend additional courses related to the dissertation field.	Jan/Feb: the supervisor writes a report on the student progress to be presented at the PhD board meeting. The supervisor is required to attend her/his advisee's seminar.
	2 <sup>nd</sup> term		Student ends the 1 <sup>st</sup> paper (and eventually starts the second). She/he might need to attend additional courses related to the dissertation field.	June: the supervisor writes a report on the student progress at the end of this term to be sent to the PhD coordinator.

# Student's duty is to report and discuss on a weekly basis with the supervisor about the progress. Each student can choose different supervisors for different papers (even if not compulsory it is highly recommended).

Preliminary year  $-1^{st}$  term: Student must attend all the classes/seminars and pass the first term compulsory exams. The student is assigned a tutor.

Preliminary year  $-2^{nd}$  term: Student must attend all the classes/seminars and pass the second term compulsory exams.

 $1^{st}$  year  $-1^{st}$  term: Student must attend all the classes/seminars and pass the first term field exams. The student is assigned a tutor (if not assigned before).

 $1^{st}$  year  $-2^{nd}$  term: Student must attend all the classes/seminars and pass the second term field exams. By the end of this term the student chooses the supervisor for the "Research idea" seminar.

 $2^{nd}$  year –  $1^{st}$  term: Student must prepare the  $1^{st}$  "Research idea" seminar to motivate the main ideas and possibly to present some results (for more details on how to present see the Research seminar document). A full knowledge of the literature on the topic is expected. No more than 15 slides should be presented! The seminar lasts at most 30 minutes.

 $2^{nd}$  year –  $2^{nd}$  term: Student must conclude the  $1^{st}$  paper and starts working on the  $2^{nd}$  paper.

 $3^{rd}$  year  $-1^{st}$  term: Student must present the  $2^{nd}$  paper seminar. No more than 35 slides! The seminar lasts 50 minutes.

 $3^{rd}$  year  $-2^{nd}$  term: Student must work on the  $3^{rd}$  paper, complete and submit the thesis to the PhD board.
